A: GStarCAD is free, opensource and cross platform. It supports major platforms like Windows, Mac, Linux, Android, etc. There is free and pro versions available. GStarCAD's main features are: Open source Cross platform Real-time rendering Automatic support for geometries based on other gstarCAD files Full-featured AutoCAD plugin Direct models support Uses IPT (Unicode) for more than 65 languages Built-in basic export formats (dxf, dwg, stp, xstp, xpm, png, jpg, etc) It also has a main class for support, various plugins, and a plugin repository.
